The European Central Bank intends to award a contract for the development of a dedicated system capable of automatically measuring the printing quality of euro banknotes to the highest standards. II.2) Quantity or scope of the contract

II.2.1) Total quantity or scope:

To improve the control of banknote printing quality, specific subtle design elements should be integrated into the printing area which can be automatically recognised and checked with a specific Quality Control (QC) tool, providing critical print quality measurement. This mainly concerns features in the visible range, but could also be extended to invisible features.

Depending on the characteristics controlled, these control elements should be integrated either inside or outside the area of the banknotes, and should facilitate the evaluation of production sheets by the printers against reference sheets produced/assessed by a reference QC tool. The system that is to be developed will need to be specific to the origination and printing techniques involved in banknote security printing.

The tenderer will have to carry out the following tasks in particular:

- 1) Development/adaptation of QC methods and standards.
- 2) A study of euro banknotes in circulation, as well as benchmarking.
- 3) Development of robust QC design features for automatic measurement.
