TIPS cross-currency strategy and tentative timeline

Phase 1 → Implementation of first TIPS cross-currency settlement service <u>Phase 2</u> → Implementation of enhanced linked transaction (ELKT) settlement model Phase 3 → Improve crossborder payments by interlinking fast payment systems & enhancements of cross-currency services

Largely based on EPC's One-Leg-Out Instant Credit Transfer scheme and facilitated by intermediary banks

June 2025

Enhanced crosscurrency solution guaranteeing end-to-end instantaneity of the payments between all TIPS hosted currencies.

October 2025

Exploration of TIPS interlinking with UPI and/or Nexus. And other enhancements of crosscurrency service.

Phase 1

Implementation of first TIPS cross-currency settlement service

Phase 1 – Current status

- TIPS-0064-URD was deployed with TIPS R2025.JUN
- Allows for interactions between TIPS and other instant payments platforms, based on EPC's OCT Inst scheme and orchestrated by an intermediary crosscurrency PSP

TIPS-CG members are invited to reach out to their National Central Banks for more information on testing and usage in PROD.



Phase 2

Implementation of enhanced linked transaction (ELKT) settlement model

Phase 2 – Current status

- TIPS-0065-URD is allocated to TIPS R2025.OCT
- As previously presented in the TIPS-CG, the TIPS-CG Taskforce on TIPS crosscurrency Business Development has been created with those PSPs that sent an Lol
- Kick-off meeting with the taskforce participants was on 18 June, where we discussed:
 - Role of the taskforce in TIPS governance structure (<u>ECB website updated</u> with mandate and relevant documents will be provided)
 - Steps needed towards usage of CR65 in PROD (e.g., user testing, which starts in Summer)
 - Workplan and topics of discussion for the taskforce, including items related to a successful golive of the cross-currency service, and potential future enhancements of the service
